

Tricoter - Technical Requirements – by Foolish Operations

Details : Tricoter is a choreography of 15 minutes for public spaces. The dancers uses about 10 balls of yarn in the choreography (provided by the company). The piece is danced inside a round of approx. 20 chairs. The violinist plays seated on one of the chairs within the circle wit the audience. A red piece of yarn is placed on the chairs and the audience is asked to put it on their lap at the beginning. Those who can't sit, can stand outside the circle. Children must be seated on their adult and not on the floor in the dancing space. A teaser video can be seen at <http://www.foolishoperations.org/tricoter>

Minimum on-site technical requirements:

- Dance surface inspection (no debris)
- 1 or 2 volunteers for the chairs installation
- 20 to 25 chairs placed in a circle
- PA sound system for large or noisy public spaces (acoustic versions possible for smaller/quiet) spaces.
